

“RT 66 THROUGH OK”

You will need 1/2 yard of fusible, I used Pellon 805 Wonder Under.  
The shapes are applique with black Aurifil 50 wt thread.

Your background fabric is cut larger than you need it to be. This is to compensate for the shrinkage after doing the applique.

When all your applique is done trim to 9 1/2" X 36 1/2". I used a disappearing ink pen to mark a temporary 9 1/2" X 36 1/2" border around the background fabric to help with placement of the different shapes.

You will have to trace the images onto the fusible of your choice. Leave a 1/8" border around each shape when you cut them from the fusible. Fuse each shape to wrong side of the correct fabric, referring to the picture. Trim the fused shapes and remove the paper backing. Fuse them to the background fabric, referring to the picture for placement. You can place the shapes as you wish, you don't have to place them exactly like the picture.

*Helpful Hint: I take a pin and scrape the paper side in the middle of the shape to get the paper started. Don't peel it from the edge, this causes the edges of your shapes to fray. Peel the paper from the center where you scrapped it.*

After everything is fused, applique the shapes using the stitch of your choice. I used a blanket stitch but a straight or zig zag stitch would be fine. You could even do a hand blanket stitch. Feel free to embellish and do your own thing.
